Portfolio Project #1: "Gazetteer"

Develop a map-based application in HTML, CSS, JavaScript (jQuery) and Bootstrap presenting geographical and demographic data from JSON returned by PHP modules that query third-party APIs such as GeoNames and OpenWeather.

- Administered life safety due diligence assessments across Accenture's global real estate portfolio of 700+ properties
- Managed relationships with key global and local stakeholders, and advised on fire safety issue resolution
- Oversaw external consultant vendors in delivery of specialist services, including fire safety and natural hazards
- Coordinated development of fire safety standards for an evolving mixed real estate portfolio including office, industrial, and bespoke speciality workspaces
- Developed a desktop assessment programme in collaboration with the vendor when COVID-19 restrictions prevented onsite assessments for seismic purposes. Safety standards were maintained and fees reduced by 85%, so this approach was maintained post-COVID
- With SharePoint unable to cope with the amount of data generated in tracking building compliance and safety, directed the team to source an alternative. On completion, collaborated with its developers, producing an application that holds 700 buildings, which was adopted by other teams and is still being used
- Maintained and enhanced company-gained First Aid skills (2009) by volunteering for St John's Ambulance, and then Wembley/Fulham stadiums, which increased problem-solving skills and provided an additional external professional network
- Established a public speaking club, Toastmasters International affiliated, for UK employees as little opportunity available to practise these skills/build an associated network. Club grew significantly following setup in 2018
